Pet Pad Instructions

Thank you for your interest in sewing Pat Pads. Pet Pads are easy to make and utilize donated, recycled materials to make comfy beds that benefit homeless dogs and cats. Blankets, mattress pads, flannel sheets and pillow cases can be converted into easy to wash pads.

Finished Pet Pad Sizes

Cat Bed: 22" x 15 1/2"

Small Dog Pad 26" x 16 1/2"

Medium Dog Pad 36 x 21 3/4"

Large Dog Pad 46 x 31 1/2"

Cut out rectangle pad pattern to 1/2" larger than finished size of pet pad. A 1/4" seam allowance gives plenty of space for padding or extra padding.

Ex: Small Dog Pad; Finished size: 26 x 16 1/2"

1.) Face pad material, wrong side in and cut out a rectangle measuring 26 1/2" by 17"

2.) Cut out a piece of mattress pad to 26 x 16 1/2"

(Use 2 pieces of mattress padding to make an extra cushy pad)

3.) Pin and use a sewing machine to sew pad material with a 1/4" seam allowance and leave a 4" wide opening along one seam. Select a thread to match material pattern

4.) Turn Pad right side out, insert mattress pad and shake out to flatten.

5.) Quilt finished pad and sew last seam closed.

Completed pet pads can be dropped off at either center. Both locations are open weekdays Noon to 6 pm and weekends Noon the 3pm.
